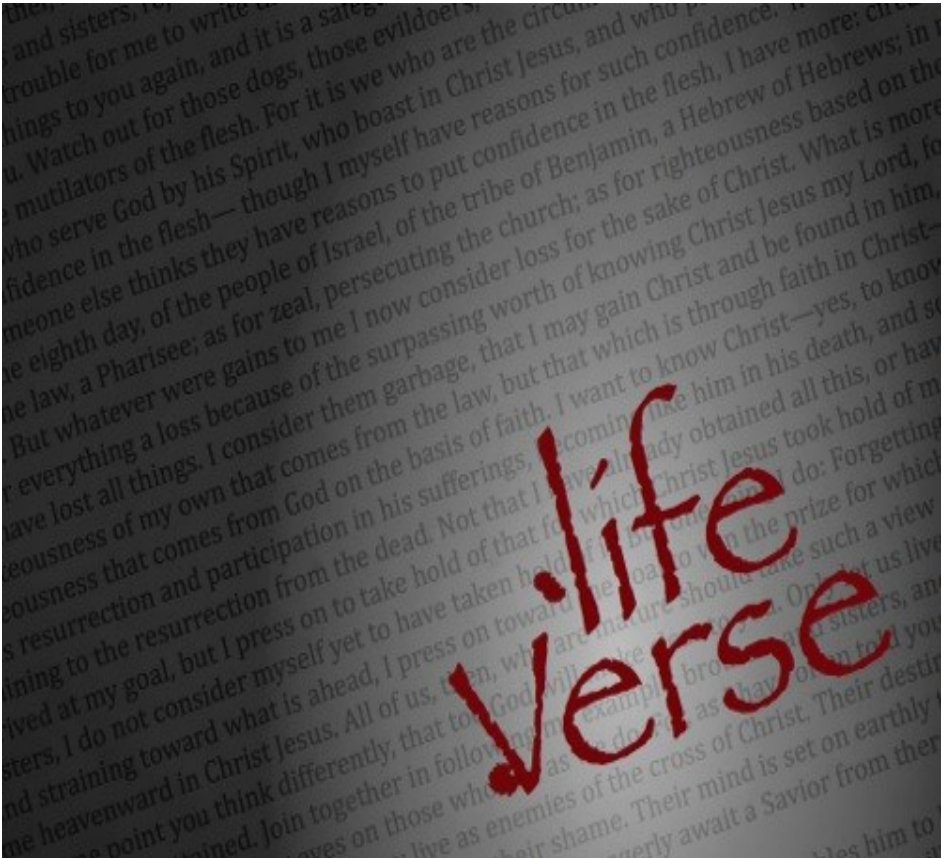

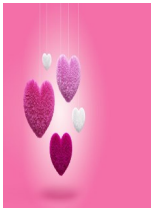

Troop 70 2018 Overview

2018 has been another year of fun and excitement for the Scouts of Troop 70! We have had a variety of activities scheduled to meet the needs of the boys and our community. Here are some of the facts and figures that describe Troop 70:

We

- * are 20 Scouts, 6 adult leaders, and 10 Troop Committee members.
- * come to Troop 70 from Frankford, Lewisburg, Maxwellton, and Renick.
- * camped for a cumulative total of over 200 nights.
- * hiked and biked a cumulative total of over 500 miles.
- * outdoor activities scheduled throughout the year including winter camping, biking, and backpacking.
- * enjoy a variety of high adventure activities – canoeing, skiing, backpacking, and rappelling.
- * honored 21 Scouts who advanced in rank and earned 89 merit badges.
- * include 23 Scouts who attended summer camp and earned over 70 merit badges.
- * assisted with the Shanghai Parade, TOOT, and Wheels of Hope.
- * removed litter along 2 miles of Route 60 as part of the Adopt-A-Highway program.
- * honored five Scouts for achieving the rank of Eagle Scout.
- Eagle service projects provided fleece blankets for addicted babies, renovated the Little League dugout, constructed an information kiosk at Carnegie Hall, constructed a soccer practice wall at EGMS, and produced an opioid-awareness video for adolescents.
- * removed over 500 pounds of the invasive species Garlic Mustard from Kates Mountain.

Highlights planned for 2019 include:

- Attend summer camp at Camp Powhatan in Virginia
- 15 Scouts and leaders will be attending the Haarlem Jamborette in the Netherlands in July.
