God's favor to proclaim.

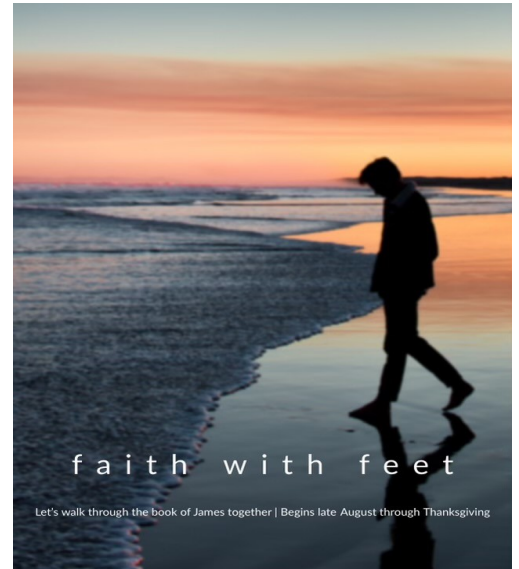
Then let us go to serve in peace,
